The pupils in Mr Potes’ Religion class are creating the “ABC of Tolerance” and occupying themselves with the history of negative stereotypes.

Mr Lankes, Ms Kehr and Ms Schrötter-Scheufens will be developing a project logo which conveys the idea “We in Europe – Shaping the future”. This will be created with reference to the topics of racism and democracy in Mr Kirk’s Politics class. The best idea will be awarded a prize and presented to the project schools at the end of January on Gran Canaria as well as during the European Week in May.



In the context of the International Day of Tolerance an impressive poster against racism and exclusion was exhibited by Mr Lankes in the foyer.

These project topics will be dealt with at the same time in our partner schools in Spain and Hungary. The first results will be compared through eTwinning and then discussed at our project meeting in January 2017.






"The balloons flew into a perfect sky with the message "We have no room for racism."


Several workshops took place on 16th November in Hungary.
