During our meeting on Gran Canaria from 12th – 16th September the timetable and the time goals of the Erasmus+ Project were adjusted between the German, Hungarian and Spanish coordinators. The German partners presented ideas for Gymnasium Kerpen and the cooperation partners, i.e. the production of a leaflet with the title “Things to know about the city of Kerpen” or a cultural bazaar. Work on the content of the project has already begun and every pupil has been asked to compile a profile of him/herself which will be displayed on a bulletin board in the schools and online at eTwinning.

The ideas already collected were supplemented by the Hungarian and Spanish perspectives during the five-day meeting, for example, participation in a “Run for Solidarity” or a “Poetry Slam”, which will continue to be developed at the home schools.

At the end of January the pupils will meet on Gran Canaria and present the ideas developed at the respective schools. They will also work on common topics, for example designing a fitting logo for the Project and research into the background of migration as well as the school integration policies of the respective countries, thereby collecting and comparing prepared thoughts and ideas.

A Facebook page with the title “We in Europe” has been created to simplify such personal project meetings and keep the interested parties informed.
